CHSAA POLICIES

- Arbiter All athletes need to have an account, and one parent/guardian
- Transfer rule As of June 1, 2018, if you transfer schools without a move, you sit Varsity competition for 365 days.
 - If you have not attended Palmer for the last 365 days, and you have not done transfer paperwork, stop by and see me!!!
- Attendance Athletes must be in class to participate
 - If they miss more than 50% of their scheduled classes, they cannot practice or play that day.
 - Their attendance on the last day of school before non-school days, impacts their ability to participate.
 - i.e. Their attendance on Friday, effects their ability to play on Saturday

CHSAA POLICIES

- Initial Eligibility
 - Freshmen are automatically eligible as long as they have at least 5 credits this semester.
 - 10th-12th graders
 - Had to take 5 full credits last semester.
 - Fail no more than one class
 - Taking at least 5 credits this semester
- Weekly Eligibility Checks Wednesdays at 3am. Can't have more than 1 F
 - Changes to eligibility ONLY IF: 1. Work made up within 2 days of excused absence OR 2. Teacher errors





- CLASSROOM SUCCESS LEADS TO ATHLETIC SUCCESS


STRENGTH
